This is an application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in Basar P.S. Case No. 20 of 2010 under Sections 302/34 IPC in connection with which the accused, Shri Tojum Taso was arrested on 05-10-2010.

The learned District & Sessions Judge, Yupia by his order dated 29-11-2010 had rejected the bail application filed on behalf of the accused and accordingly the brother of the accused has filed the present bail application.

Mr. N. Lowang, learned P.P., on the basis of instructions received, submits that the charge sheet in the case has not yet been filed and the accused has already spent 102 days in custody following his arrest on 05-10-2010.

In view of the above, bail for the accused Tojum Taso is allowed. Accordingly, on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.20,000/- with one local surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Basar, accused Tojum Taso shall be allowed to go on bail.

However, the accused during the bail period shall cooperate with the investigation and also refrain from influencing the other witnesses in the case.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
