I have heard Mr. R. H. Nabam, learned Senior Government Advocate, appearing on behalf of State respondents No. 1, 2 and 3.

The petitioner, hereinbefore, has challenged the transfer order dated 03.10.2008 (Annexure-VI to the writ petition).
