Heard Mr. S. Tapin, learned counsel for the petitioners, and Mr. RH Nabam, learned Senior Govt. Advocate, appearing for the respondents.

By making this writ petition, under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have, essentially, sought for issuance of appropriate writ(s) commanding the respondents to hold a review DPC for the purpose of making promotion to the post of Assistant Engineer.

On taking up this writ petition for consideration, the learned Senior Govt. Advocate has submitted that the review DPC has been held, on 27.12.2010, and that the result of the review DPC would be shortly announced and necessary follow-up action will be taken expeditiously.

Considering the matter in its entirety and in the interest of justice, this writ petition, as agreed to by the learned counsel for the parties, is disposed of with direction to the respondents to complete, within a period of two months from today, the process of making promotion to the posts of Assistant Engineer, which form the subject-matter of controversy in this writ petition.

With the above observations and directions, this writ petition shall stand disposed of.
